How you can manage cookies

If you disable all cookies in your browser settings, neither we nor third parties would be able to place cookies in your browser. This may fundamentally affect the proper functionality of our site, however, on the other hand you may have to manually adjust your settings every time you visit.

These cookies are used to measure the effectiveness of our site and perform services on Neurolytics behalf. What are cookies?

A cookie is a piece of data stored in the user’s browser or device, containing information about the user and used to subsequently identify the user.. This can be in the form of session cookies and/or stored cookies and may include that information which the user provides to us such as: your preferred language, location, user ID and password, first name and last name, home address, work address, email address, telephone number, etc.

Will a user who rejects the cookie still use our website?

We use cookies for a variety of reasons, such as to determine preferences, let users navigate between pages efficiently, verify the user and carry out other essential security checks, and enable the user participate in our online video assessment.

Do cookies mean I could get cold calls or junk mail?

We never use the data gathered through cookies to contact you via post, email or telephone. We may use cookies to show you subtly tailored content on our website or other websites of things we think you might be interested in, but only in relation to Neurolytics products and services. You will never see advertising on our website from anyone other than us.

Do cookies compromise my security when I am logged on to this website?

The cookies we use are completely safe. Many of them are for providing important security features such as protecting your data and your accounts. We use cookies to safeguard your privacy when you are browsing our website.

What type of cookies do you store?

Neurolytics may collect personal data from your browser or device when you interact with our site. The data we collect is on the basis of your consent and preference with the exception of functional cookies which are essential for the proper functioning of the site. We use cookies to collect information such as your browser type, IP-address etc. Similarly, in the course of your interaction with our site, third party service providers may also collect your information through their cookies. They do this by directly collecting information from your browser, and processing this data subject to their privacy policies.
